

Surfside Beach Historical & Preservation Society
Board meeting minutes of October 7, 2015

Ben called meeting to order at 4:00p.m. at the Floral Field Clubhouse.

Attending: Ben Burroughs, Joyce Suliman, Sadie Parmely, and Sherry Singleton.

Sherry read the minutes of the August 19, 2015 general meeting; discussion, corrections and additions were made. Vote was taken and minutes were approved. September 2, 2015 board meeting minutes were read, discussed, corrections and additions made. Vote was taken and minutes were approved.

Ben led discussion reviewing the officers' jobs and responsibilities.

Joyce reported she had spoken to Councilman, Randal Stephens, regarding the effort to purchase the two lots in the old cemetery area. He said the town has no money for purchase

Ben reported progress regarding the archaeological dig at the Ark Plantation home site: Susan McMillan of the Waccamaw Archeology Partnership has offered to inspect the property and do the dig at no charge. A plat of the property is needed.

Joyce reminded us that we are not yet an approved committee of the Town of Surfside Beach. October 13, there will be a meeting of the Town Councils' Historical Committee at which the Historical & Preservation Society will be discussed,. In 2012 the Town approved the formation of the Surfside Beach Historical Board. At the October 27 Town Council Meeting, presentation of a repeal regarding the original Historical Board and a proposal for the newly formed Historical & Preservation Society will be offered for consideration.


Budget: Discussion focused on finding ways to achieve goals using volunteers, donated items, and coordinating with other town services and committees.
