Discussion:

Brookgreen Gardens speakers, Vicki Richardson and Christy Anouilh spoke on seasonal blooms that would thrive in our area (mixed perennials, fox-glove, pansies, evergreen perennials). Plants that are tolerant to heat and require less watering would be beneficial to the area. More compost makes foliage thrive. Time released fertilizer . Mulching after planting to make it look nice and holds in moisture. Preparing the soil properly (till, compost, etc.) is important.

“Book of Lists” by Lois Trig Chaplain is a great guide for trees, vines, plants and shrubs. Available through Amazon for \$13.46 is recommended.

Butterfly gardens: lantana, butterfly bush, nectar plants and host plants are attractive to butterflies. Suggested spots would be in parks through out the town.

Espoma is organic fertilizer and a pesticide is needed for holly tone and roses.

Keep flowers deadheaded for more bloom time.
