

RALPH MAGLIETTE SENIOR CITIZENS COMMITTEE
September 30, 2019 Meeting
Minutes

Members Present: Committee Chairman, Steve Shore; Committee Members Gail King, Kat Brown, Joe Buczek and Event Supervisor Debbie Ellis. Absent: Committee Member, Linda McKeen. Public attendees: Carol Lucas

Meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m. in Council Chambers by Chairman Steve Shore. Minutes from the August 26, 2019 meeting were submitted for approval. Gail King made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Joe Buczek. All voted in favor.

Business:

- Carol Lucas spoke to the Committee regarding the South Strand Senior Center and asked that the committee do what they could to support the facility, not necessarily with funding but acceptance that the facility was a necessity in the town.
- Gail King reported that a meeting was scheduled for Thursday, October 3rd, at 10 a.m. with Mayor Childs and Horry County regarding the neglect of the facility by the county.
- Debbie Ellis stated she would check with the Town Clerk regarding the contract with Horry County to obtain a copy.
- It was reported by Debbie Ellis that 24 vendors were registered for the Senior Fair. Copies of last year's vendors who have not responded were distributed to the committee to make selections on who would contact these vendors. Ms. Ellis also reported that a total of \$460.00 had been received in vendor fees.
- Steve Shore reported that there were remaining giveaways from last year's event and the committee voted to distribute these at their booth at the Family Festival and to limit one per person.
- Debbie Ellis reported the only upcoming expenses would be tablecloths and drinks/water for the committee.
- Decision was made by committee to not hire a DJ for this year's event.
- It was reported by Steve Shore that the new council liaison for the committee is Councilmember Bruce Dietrich.
- Committee voted to have copies of the Senior Fair Flyer at their booth at the Family Festival as well as a bag of candy for the children and possibly a donation box for the South Strand Senior Center.
- Committee requested that the Senior Fair flyer be taken to JerriBob's and have 25 posters printed for local churches, library, etc.

Gail King made a motion to adjourn, Joe Buczek seconded.
