

**RALPH MAGLIETTE SENIOR CITIZENS COMMITTEE**  
**April 29, 2019 Meeting**  
**Minutes**

**Members Present:** Committee Chairman, Steve Shore Committee Members Joe Buczek, Gail King, Kat Brown, and Event Supervisor, Debbie Ellis. Absent: Committee Member, Linda McKeen. Visitors: Tanika Parson, Police Department

Meeting was called to order at 4:27 p.m. in Council Chambers by Chairman Steve Shore. Minutes from the March 25, 2019 meeting were submitted for approval. Joe Buczek made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Gail King. All voted in favor.

**Business:**

- Event Supervisor presented the Committee's expense report for the budget year 2018-2019. Revenue and expenses from the Senior Fair, the Senior Dance and assistance at the Senior Center showed a revenue balance of \$623.82.
- Committee agreed to spend the remaining balance on giveaways for the upcoming Senior Fair in October. Committee voted to purchase plastic cups and pens.
- Event Supervisor presented Committee with last year's Senior Fair letter and application for review and to report any changes and/or additions necessary.
- Committee voted to replace Walgreens Pharmacy with CVS Pharmacy at the Senior Fair to administer flu shots and pneumonia shots. CVC is in town.
- Suggestions for upcoming Senior Fair included:
  1. A shredding company be on site
  2. A solution to destroy out of date medication – possibly the method used by the Police Department.
  3. A local medical office to conduct blood pressure checks, blood sugar checks, etc. Gail King and Kat Brown will contact the new urgent care center scheduled to open soon at 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South.

Tanika Parson from the Surfside Beach Police Department spoke to the Committee regarding the Community Alert Program. Citizens on the program, normally confined to the home or have disabilities, are checked on once a week either with a visit or by phone. Ms. Parson would like to get the Senior Committee involved with this program and hopefully raise participation. Committee agreed to help in any way possible.

Gail King made a motion to adjourn, Steve Shore seconded.
