EVENTS

The town's annual Memorial Day Golf Cart Parade was held Sunday, May 26th on Ocean Blvd. Last year's entries totaled 52 golf carts and this year there was a total of 70 participants in the parade.

A Memorial Day Service was held on Monday, May 27th at 2 p.m. at the Veterans Memorial. Speaker was Matthew Breen, President of the Sons of the American Revolution. Myrtle Beach Fire Department Honor Guard participated once again and their Lt. Jon Evans performed the national anthem.

Crafter's Cove for children ages 10 & under, sponsored by EdVenture of Myrtle Beach, will begin Wednesday, June 12th and will continue on Wednesdays through August 14th with the exception of the week of the 4th of July. This is a drop in event which consists of an educational lesson on marine life and a craft for the children to participate in.
