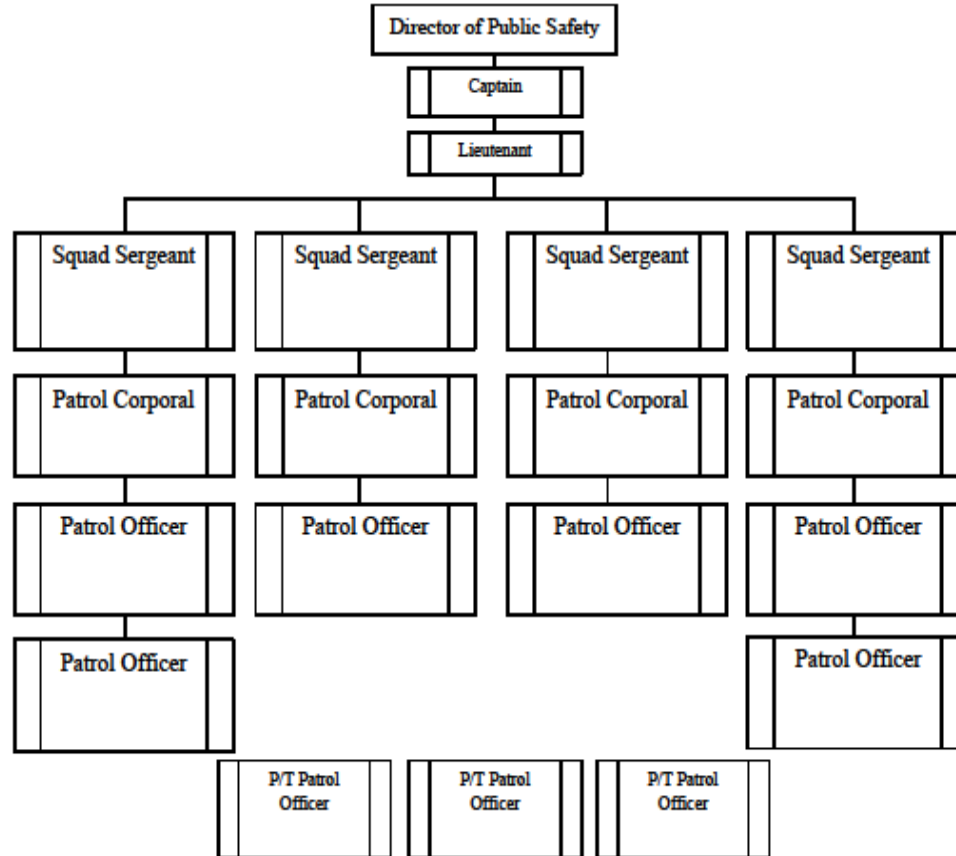

(2010)

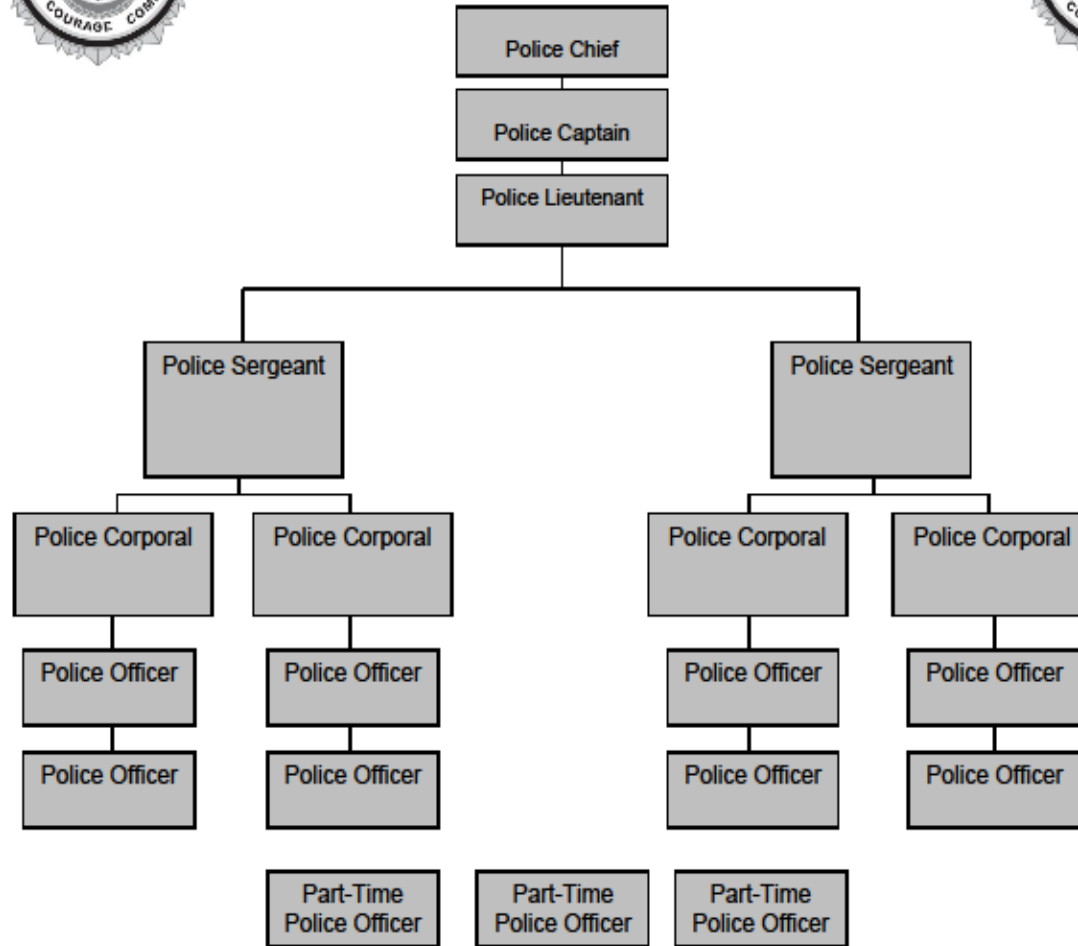

Vehicle / Fleet Resources

- 9 police patrol vehicles
- 1 special service beach truck (seasonal)
- 1 inmate transport van (grant funded)
- 5 admin vehicles (investigators, command, etc.)
- 1 narcotics vehicle (funded w/ seized funds)
- 1 civilian vehicle (academy, lab trips, etc)



Vehicle / Fleet Resources

- Police vehicle staggering
 - Vehicles last longer
 - Lower maintenance costs
- Force multiplier: cars = officers in the field
 - All hands deployments / events
 - May rallies
 - Hurricanes
