

RALPH MAGLIETTE SENIOR CITIZENS COMMITTEE
April 30, 2018 Meeting
Minutes

Members Present: Steve Shore, Chairman; Committee Members Joe Buzcek and Linda McKeen, and Event Supervisor, Debbie Ellis

Meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m. at Council Chambers. There were no previous minutes presented for approval. With the resignation of the committee's secretary, Shelby Smith, the committee suggested Ms. Ellis record the minutes until Mr. Smith's position of the committee is filled. Ms. Ellis accepted.

Business:

The committee had not met since the Senior Fair in October of 2017 due to last minute scheduling of council meetings, pier workshops, etc.

Ms. Ellis presented the following information regarding the Senior Fair in October of 2017 to each committee member:

- Feedback postcards
- Registration sheets
- Information regarding a duo who would like to provide entertainment for this year's Senior Fair – committee voted for Ms. Ellis to contact the duo.
- Expense and revenue reports
- There were four raffle prizes that had not been claimed. Consensus was Ms. McKeen would randomly call from registration sheets and award these prizes.

The committee had previously recommended the possibility of a Seniors Dance and Senior Sports day. With only three members on the committee, recommendation was made and approved to focus solely on the upcoming Senior Fair in October and to defer these events until a full committee was seated.

Recommendations for the Senior Fair were approved by the committee as follows:

- Date will be Friday, October 19, 2018 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- To limit vendors to three (3) doing the same business.
- Any vendor who leaves early will not be allowed back.
- Secure Walgreens for flu and pneumonia shots
- Secure Wal-Mart Vision for vision screenings
- Request Cold Stone Creamery (David Pellegrino) participate again
- Chairman Shore will approach South State Bank for sponsorship of the event
- Have Ms. Ellis purchase giveaways for event, specifically flashlights and sewing kits
- Check with Fire Department regarding cooking and selling food for the event. If not, secure food trucks again.
- Committee will provide drinks and water again

Discussion was held regarding polo shirts, white with royal blue print, be purchased for committee members. Ms. Ellis will check on prices.

Committee agreed on a booth for the Surfside Beach Family Festival on Saturday, October 6th.

Next meeting was scheduled for Monday, June 25th at 5:30 p.m. Meeting was adjourned.
