**To Officially Name the Passive Park Area the  
 Surfside Beach Memorial Park**

**WHEREAS**, the Town owns 2.08 acres of land bordered by Surfside Drive, Willow Drive, and Pine Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, this area has become known as the 'passive park' even though it provides exercise stations, walking trails, two dog parks, a swing, the town's Veterans Memorial, public restrooms, parking, and is host to multiple events such as the Farmers Market and Sunday Serenades; and

**WHEREAS**, Town Council finds the moniker lacks dignity and in no way reflects the grandeur of the area, or the many opportunities offered.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Surfside Beach Town Council hereby officially names the area formerly referred to as 'passive park' as the **Surfside Beach Memorial Park**, which may commonly referred to as "Memorial Park," and henceforth shall be so named in any publications or reference thereto.
