**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SURFSIDE BEACH  
TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN  
ORDINANCES THAT PROHIBIT THE POSTING  
ADVERTISEMENTS ON PROPERTY.**

**WHEREAS,** a request was made to allow the Candidates for the 2021 Election to distribute flyers during their campaigning; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town of Surfside Beach is willing to allow for the disbursement of flyers only during the time period of October 12, 2021 until November 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town is willing to temporarily suspend enforcement of certain ordinances to allow Candidates for the 2021 Election to distribute flyers.

**WHEREAS,** the time of the suspension shall commence on October 12, 2021 and end on November 1, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFOR,** Town Council desires to temporarily suspend enforcement of certain provisions of its Code of Ordinances as set forth as follows:

- 1. Chapter 8 Sec. 8-68. - Posting advertisements on property.** (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to post any advertisement of any kind on public property within the town by use of a placard, picture, paper, circular, painting, poster or by any means or device whatsoever. (b) It shall be unlawful to place any such advertisement, business or otherwise or any notice or sign of any nature on private property within the town without the consent of the owner or lessee of the property.
