**WHEREAS,** The Town Council of the Town of Surfside Beach is vested with all administrative powers of the municipality. §5-11-30, S.C. Code Ann.; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Surfside Beach has commenced its project to replace the wooden Surfside Beach Pier; and

**WHEREAS,** In December 2020, the contractor for the new pier project demolished remaining structures of the wooden pier; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town Council, acknowledging potential nostalgic value, has secured certain wood salvaged from the demolition of the wooden pier to make it available to the public, in the Town’s best interests; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town Council is authorized to sell personal property of the Town to the public at such terms and conditions as Town Council deems advisable; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town Council has determined \$10 (ten dollars) per board foot is a reasonable price to charge for salvaged pier wood, in the best interests of the Town and its citizens, and the competitive bidding process in Chapter II of the Surfside Beach Town Code is not applicable to salvage wood sale at this price; and

**WHEREAS,** Offering the wood to the public at this price is advisable and advantageous to the Town;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Town Council of the Town of Surfside Beach hereby sets forth the terms for the sale of the salvaged wood from the old Surfside Beach Pier as follows:

1. Wood pick-up/sale shall be conducted Wednesday, February 10, 2021, 9 am-12:00 pm, on Scipio Lane, Surfside Beach, South Carolina.
2. Wood pick-up/sale shall continue each consecutive Wednesday at the same location and for the same time period until all wood has been sold or otherwise disposed of or utilized by the Town for public purpose, in the discretion of the Town Administrator or his designee.
3. Wood shall be offered to the public by the board foot at \$10 (ten dollars) per foot.
4. Wood shall be sold on a first come – first served basis, with each buyer limited to 10 board feet per person, to make the salvaged pier wood available to more

members of the public for nostalgic reasons keeping with Town Council's wishes. Wood will not be held or reserved.

5. Sales shall be conducted by Town Staff with COVID-19 protocols in place, as recommended by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control.
6. Acceptable forms of payments are cash, credit card, and check. Payments are to be made at Town Hall. Receipts shall be issued to buyers to present to Town Staff at pick up site, and proceeds shall be deposited into the Pier Fund.

**SEVERABILITY.** If any provision, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be held invalid, that invalidity shall not affect its other provisions.
